- 3) to accept the scientific guidelines of ISPRA and the Scientific Committee of the NMD Network in relation to the modalities and standards of acquisition, verification and processing of mycological data referred to in "Guidelines for the census and monitoring of macromycetes in Italy" published on the site;
- 4) to be aware that participation in the NMD Network as a contributor is intended to collect and voluntarily send mycological data from field operations or from personal archives and/or bibliography and to collect and send samples fungi deriving from field operations or from personal archives according to methods and standards defined by the Network;
- 5) to authorize the systematization of the sent data will be systematized in the Fungi Information System (SIF) of ISPRA that will report next to each published record contributor's name and surname unless he/she wish to remain anonymous;
- 6) to authorise the storage of fungal samples sent to the NMD Network in the ISPRA fungarium at the headquarters in Ozzano dell'Emilia (BO) registered in the *Index Herbariorum* and that the label associated with the sample will be the contributor's name and surname unless he/she wish to remain anonymous;
- 7) to be aware that data sent voluntarily to ISPRA are shared with the NMD Network in line with the FAIR principles. The data may be disclosed or be the subject of scientific publications by the contributor and/or by the NDM Network, provided that there must be clear reference to the source of the data, i.e. the Fungi Information System (SIF);
- 8) to authorise the free transfer of fungal samples to the ISPRA fungarium and, if explicitly requested, genetic analysis whose results may be disclosed or be the subject of scientific publications both by the contributor and by the NDM Network, provided that there must be clear reference to the source of the data.
